During the summer months, we will spend most of our time outdoors exploring the beautiful Birds Eye View Park together. From bubbles and bugs to outdoor story-time and nature adventures, each session is designed to spark curiosity, imagination, and connection for both children and caregivers alike!

DESCRIPTION: Join us for our BRAND-NEW hiking program, 3 peaks 1 summer. This program is designed to be a leisurely, fun, interpretive hiking experience, offering a chance to discover stunning landscapes right here in our own little hamlet while learning along the way. Whether you're brand new to hiking or already love the trails, this is a welcoming opportunity to get outside, build confidence, and enjoy the mountains in good company. We've tackled our first two peaks and we're ready to conquer our third and final peak of the summer! Join us as we tackle Flood Mountain.

Open to ages 18+ and all experience levels.

Trailhead: From the tourism centre drive 10.4 km south on hwy 40. The Flood Mountain Trailhead is on the north (left) side of hwy, just before the bridge over the railway tracks. If road conditions allow, drive a further 2 km up the logging road staying right at the first junction and left at the second. Roughly 2 km from the highway the Flood Mountain trail leaves the logging road on the right hand side, park here. If you would prefer to follow Tourism staff to the trailhead please let us know upon registration.
